Hammitt Elementary School

Our accredited schools provide special education services for children whose needs can't be met in public schools special education programs. Serving K - 6th grade.

Hammitt Junior-Senior High School

Personalizing special education, crisis and therapeutic interventions, and vocational education to help children find academic and social success. Serving ages 12 - 21.

Autism Services

Designed to meet the needs of students with autism and/or severe communication disorders who cannot be served successfully in a less restrictive classroom setting.

Community Schools

Expert social workers are embedded in Unit 5 Schools to support trauma-impacted children and their families, so the student can remain in their local public school.

Camp Programs

Students with special needs practice social skills learned during the school year, make new friends, and create lasting positive memories.

Foster Care, Adoption from Foster Care

Recruiting, training, and certifying foster families willing to open their hearts and homes to children. Providing safe, loving families for trauma-impacted children.

Healthy Start

Early intervention program breaking the cycle of abuse and neglect for children. Helping new families relate and create loving memories with their kids.

Caregiver Connections

Childhood mental health consultants travel to childcare centers and preschools, observe classrooms, and help identify and respond to children's emotional and behavioral struggles.

Adoption Support and Preservation

Supporting families who have adopted children. When family challenges arise, we offer support, consultation, resources, and professional therapy at no cost to families.

Intact Family Services

Providing comprehensive case management services, advocacy, support, referrals, and education to families that are at risk of losing their children.

Training, Consultation, and Certification

The Baby Fold is called upon at the local, state, and national levels to bring expert instruction to those in the field of child welfare.
