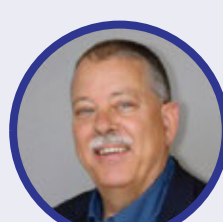
Cory Tello

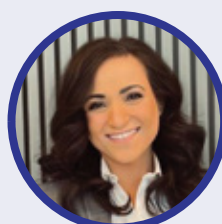
Julie Baller
