  - 2 pocket folders with prongs (paper or poly)
  - Skinny Expo dry erase markers; all colors
  - AAA batteries
- For school readiness:
  - Ticonderoga My First Pencils (helps students of all abilities develop fine motor skills)
  - Post it notes (lined or unlined) (all sizes)
  - Colored index cards (lined or unlined)
  - Individual small plastic pencil sharpeners
  - Children's scissors (left and right handed)
  - 8"X5" plastic supply boxes
  - Crayola classic and fine point markers, colored pencils, and crayons
- For graduation parties, honor roll parties, the Christmas program, field trips, institute day and community based education programs:
  - Gifts cards to Amazon, Wal-Mart, Meijer, Target, Hobby Lobby, or Michael's
