To Students, Staff and Families,

March 14, 2020

Due to the ever-changing nature of the Covid-19 Coronavirus Governor Pritzker has currently directed all schools in Illinois to close beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020 and to re-open schools on Tuesday March 31st. As part of the Governor's plan, schools are to provide alternative learning activities for students to complete while they are at home. Hammitt Schools at The Baby Fold will have students and staff report to school on Monday, March 16, 2020 for a regularly scheduled school day. On Monday students will be given a packet of home based learning activities to work on while they are at home. The schoolwork provided is individualized educational activities based on student goals. The purpose of these home based alternative learning activities is for students to maintain their academic progress during this extended break in school. Directions for the activities and staff contact information will be in the alternative learning packets for the parent/guardians to utilize. If your child is absent from school on Monday, you will receive your alternative learning packet via delivery.

To outline our school schedule for the next few weeks;

Monday, March 16th- Regular school attendance day for students and staff.

Tuesday, March 17th- Friday, March 20th- Home based learning activities found in your alternative learning packets.

Monday, March 23rd- Friday, March 27th- Regularly scheduled Spring break- no school and no homebased alternative learning activities need to be completed for these days

Monday, March 30th- Home based learning activities found in your alternative learning packets.

Tuesday, March 31st - Regular school attendance day for students and staff. NOTE: The Governor may extend the time that schools are to be closed based on the status of the virus.

As information changes and we receive guidance from our local and state authorities we will keep you informed. The safety of our students, families and staff are our upmost concern.
