 - 2 pocket poly/plastic folders (without prongs)
 - 8.5" X 11.75" college ruled legal pads (with 3 hole punch)
 - 3 subject college ruled spiral bound notebook
 - 1"-3" 3 ring binder
 - Writing pens (all colors)
- For Life Books to provide to foster children:
 - Binders, dividers, glue, scissors
 - Scrapbook paper, stickers, glitter
- For foster family transportation and healthy eating
 - Gift cards to Wal-Mart, HyVee, Kroger, Schnucks or other grocery stores
 - Gift cards to Casey's General Store, Shell, Mobile, or other gas stations
- For Welcome Dinners and Ice Cream Social:
